CANFOR IS COMMITTED TO PROMOTE SUSTAINABLE FOREST MANAGEMENT BY CONDUCTING AND MAINTAINING OUR RISK ASSESSMENT PROGRAM FOR SOURCING WOOD FIBRE.

CANFOR WILL UPHOLD THE PRINCIPLES OF THE FOREST STEWARDSHIP COUNCIL AND TAKE ALL REASONABLE MEASURES TO AVOID SOURCING ROUND WOOD AND LUMBER FROM THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES:

1. Illegally harvested wood;
2. Wood harvested in violation of traditional and civil rights;
3. Wood harvested in forests where high conservation values are threatened by management activities;
4. Wood harvested in forests being converted to plantations or non-forest use;
5. Wood from forests in which genetically modified trees are planted.
