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Canadian Forest Products Ltd. - Vavenby 2005 SFM Performance Highlights:

SFM Plan performance requirements were achieved for 28 of 29 indicators relating to the sustainability criteria in the Kamloops TSA SFM Plan being reported on. The following highlights Canfor - Vavenby's contribution to the Kamloops TSA 2005 Sustainable Forest Management Plan Report.

- Canadian Forest Products Ltd. - Vavenby obtained the CAN / CSA Z809:2002 third party certification in October 2005.
- Canadian Forest Products Ltd. - Vavenby achieved full compliance with Kamloops LRMP caribou strategies (13.9 hectares harvested).
- Regeneration of harvested blocks occurred within 15 months on average from the time of harvesting compared to a target of 36 months.
- New road cuts and fill slopes were seeded on average within 6 months of disturbance, compared to a target of 36 months.
- Canadian Forest Products Ltd. - Vavenby reported a total of 1 working relationship with First Nations (e.g. business contracts, partnerships, joint ventures, etc.). Archaeological assessments were completed on 21 blocks.
- 100% of blocks with Visual Quality Objectives achieved the visual intent (15 blocks)

SFM Plan performance targets were not achieved for 1 of 29 indicators relating to the sustainability criteria in the Kamloops TSA SFM Plan. Targets were not achieved for Indicator 15 as follows:
Not all roads received a risk rating for the purpose of inspection. Vavenby is in the process of implementing a new information management system for improved data management (including roads) and much of the data is in a period of transition. Full implementation is expected during 2006.
