

## Backgrounder: Canfor Corporation

- Canfor Corporation is one of the world’s largest producers of sustainable lumber, pulp and paper, and a North American leader in green energy production. Headquartered in Vancouver, British Columbia (“BC”), the company has operations in BC, Alberta, North and South Carolina, Alabama, Georgia, Mississippi and Arkansas. Canfor also owns a 54.8% interest in Canfor Pulp Products Inc., which is one of the largest producers of market northern bleached softwood kraft pulp and a leading producer of high performance kraft paper.
- Canfor Corporation is listed on the Toronto Stock Exchange under the symbol CFP and Canfor Pulp Products Inc. is also listed on the Toronto Stock Exchange under the symbol CFX.
- Canfor owns 38 production facilities, 21 of which are in British Columbia, Canada, 2 in Alberta, Canada and 15 in the U.S. South (Alabama, Arkansas, Georgia, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina).
- The majority of operations are lumber production facilities but the company also operates pulp mills, pellet plants, a seedling nursery and a green energy facility.
- In addition to producing dimension lumber, a significant and increasing proportion of Canfor’s lumber is made up of specialty and high-value products and is shipped globally
- Canfor’s history dates back to 1938 and celebrates its 80<sup>th</sup> anniversary this year.
